- Quiet time **10:30 PM – 7 AM**
(excessive noise or loud music will not be tolerated)

- The main washroom building is closed for deep cleaning daily between **11:00 AM – 2:00 PM**

Keeping wildlife wild and communities safe

Please follow the **WildSafe BC** Bare campsite program while on site.

Always store food and coolers in a locked vehicle when you are away from your site or sleeping.

Garbage and Recycle located near the Main Washroom Building ([see map](#)).

Wildlife Attractants

- Don't leave animal attractants (anything with a scent) unattended on your site or in your tent when you leave or go to sleep.
- Store everything in your vehicle.
- Wildlife attractants include, but aren't limited to: food, garbage, coolers, **EMPTY COOLERS**, BBQs, bins, dirty stoves, dirty dishes, cans, empty cans or bottles, soap, and toiletries.
- Dirty campsites will be cleaned immediately by staff and will result in a **\$25 cleaning fee** charged to the credit card on file.
- If it happens again, you will be evicted without a refund.



Pets

- Pets must always be on a leash.
- Dogs may not be left unattended at any time (excessive barking will not be tolerated).
- Animal stool must be picked up and placed in garbage cans.
- Animals are not allowed in washrooms, or office (except guide dogs).

Generator Use

- Generator use is permitted between **9 AM - 10:30 AM** and **5 PM - 7 PM** daily to allow campers a quiet and enjoyable experience.

Campfires

- Be informed about any current fire BANS or restrictions.
- Fire Pits must not be moved.
- Fire Size - fires must be contained within the firepit provided. It is illegal to have a fire outside of a designated location.
- Do not burn garbage or collect deadfall for burning.
- Campfires are not permitted during quiet hours (**10:30 PM - 7 AM**).
- Fires must always be attended.
- During Fire Bans CSA approved propane and charcoal BBQs permitted.

Cancellation & Refund Policy

- Cancelled reservations will incur a \$25 cancellation fee (includes \$7 non-refundable booking fee + \$18 cancellation service fee)
- If cancelling 8 days (or more) prior to your date of arrival, a \$25 cancellation fee will apply and remainder of the cost will be refunded.
- Cancellations made 7 days (or less) prior to arrival are completely non-refundable for any reason.
- No refunds are given for early checkouts, with no exceptions.
- No refunds are given to anyone who is evicted from the campground
- No refunds will be given if you have booked a smaller site than you need to accommodate your RV length.
- No refunds will be given due to weather.
